## A BILL

- To amend the Migratory Bird Treaty Act to provide for penalties and enforcement for intentionally taking protected avian species, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Migratory Bird Treaty
- 5 Act Penalty and Enforcement Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT OF MIGRATORY BIRD TREATY ACT.
- 7 Section 6 of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (16
- 8 U.S.C. 707) is amended by redesignating subsections (c)

- 1 and (d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively, and by
- 2 inserting after subsection (b) the following:
- 3 "(c)(1) Except in the case of hunting and other activ-
- 4 ity allowed under section 3, whoever, in violation of this
- 5 Act, intentionally takes by any manner any migratory bird
- 6 shall be guilty of a felony, and, upon conviction, shall be
- 7 fined not more than \$50,000 for each violation or impris-
- 8 oned for not more than one year, or both.
- 9 "(2) Any person who intentionally commits any other
- 10 act or omission in violation of this Act or any regulations
- 11 issued under this Act shall, upon conviction, be guilty of
- 12 a felony and shall be fined not more than \$25,000 for each
- 13 violation or imprisoned for not more than six months, or
- 14 both.".
