7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (C) of section
8 621(a)(1) of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety

Act of 2006 (42 U.S.C. 16981(a)(1)) is amended to read
 as follows:

3	"(C) MINIMUM STANDARDS.—The elec-
4	tronic monitoring units used in the pilot pro-
5	gram shall at a minimum—
6	"(i) provide a tracking device for each
7	offender that contains a central processing
8	unit with global positioning system; and
9	"(ii) permit continuous monitoring of
10	offenders 24 hours a day.".
11	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
12	subsection (a) shall apply to grants provided on or after
13	the date of the enactment of this Act.
