1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONTINUED FEDERAL EMPLOYMENT STATUS**

4 **FOR CHRISTOPHER FREKING.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 3328 of
6 title 5, United States Code, Christopher Freking shall be
7 deemed to be eligible for appointment to a position in an
8 Executive agency.

9 (b) ADJUSTMENT TO STATUS.—Notwithstanding sec-
10 tion 3328 of title 5, United States Code, Christopher
11 Freking shall be considered to have been lawfully ap-

- 1 pointed and continuously employed by the Department of
- 2 Veterans Affairs since April 29, 1991.
