A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide for the eligibility of reserve component members supporting contingency operations for educational assistance based on cumulative days of active duty service.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Guard and

5 Reserve Active Duty Higher Education Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF RESERVE COMPONENT MEMBERS**2 **SUPPORTING CONTINGENCY OPERATIONS**
3 **FOR EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE BASED ON**
4 **CUMULATIVE DAYS OF ACTIVE DUTY SERV-**
5 **ICE.**6 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 16162(c)(4) of title 10,

7 United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

9 (A) by striking “90 consecutive days” and
10 inserting “90 cumulative days”; and11 (B) by striking “one continuous year” and
12 inserting “365 cumulative days”;

13 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

14 (A) by striking “one continuous year” and
15 inserting “365 cumulative days”; and16 (B) striking “two continuous years” and
17 inserting “730 cumulative days”; and18 (3) in subparagraph (C) by striking “two con-
19 tinuous years” and inserting “730 cumulative days”.20 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
21 this section shall apply with respect to educational assist-
22 ance paid for months beginning on or after the date of
23 the enactment of this Act.
