- $9\,\,$ the following new paragraph:

- 1 "(22) Real Property Taxes.—The deduction al-
- 2 lowed by section 164 for real property taxes described in
- 3 section 164(a)(1).".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 5 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
- 6 December 31, 2007.
