A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to make technical corrections to the new border tunnels and passages offense.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OFFENSE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 27 of title 18, United
5 States Code, is amended by redesignating section 554
6 added by section 551(a) of the Department of Homeland
7 Security Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public Law 109–295;
8 120 Stat. 1389) (relating to border tunnels and passages)
9 as section 555.

1 (b) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections for
2 chapter 27 of title 18, United States Code, is amended
3 by striking the item relating to section 554, “Border tun-
4 nels and passages”, and inserting the following:

“555. Border tunnels and passages.”.

5 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL FORFEITURE.**

6 Section 982(a)(6) of title 18, United States Code, is
7 amended by striking “554” and inserting “555”.

8 **SEC. 3. DIRECTIVE TO THE UNITED STATES SENTENCING**
9 **COMMISSION.**

10 Section 551(d) of the Department of Homeland Secu-
11 rity Appropriations Act, 2007 (Public Law 109–295; 120
12 Stat. 1390) is amended in paragraphs (1) and (2)(A) by
13 striking “554” and inserting “555”.
