To suspend temporarily the duty on Ancamine® 2432 Curing
Agent.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANCAMINE® 2432 CURING AGENT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	A modified aliphatic amine mixture containing: benzyl alcohol (CAS No. 100–51–6), formaldehyde, polymer with 1,3-benzenedimethanamine and phenol (CAS No. 57214–10–5), 1,3-benzenedimethanamine (CAS No. 1477–55–0), phenol, 4,4′-(1-methylethyldene)bis-, polymer with 2-(chloromethyl)oxirane, reaction products with ethylenediamine (CAS No. 72480–18–3), and ethylenediamine (CAS No. 107–15–3) (provided for in subheading 3909.30.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
