## A BILL

To impose a moratorium on certain Medicaid payment restrictions.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MORATORIUM ON CERTAIN PAYMENT RESTRIC-
- 4 TIONS.
- 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
- 6 retary of Health and Human Services shall not, prior to
- 7 the date that is one year after the date of the enactment
- 8 of this Act, take any action (through promulgation of reg-
- 9 ulation, issuance of regulatory guidance, use of federal
- 10 payment audit procedures, or other administrative action,

- 1 policy, or practice, including a Medical Assistance Manual
- 2 transmittal or letter to State Medicaid directors) to re-
- 3 strict coverage or payment under title XIX of the Social
- 4 Security Act for rehabilitation services, or school-based
- 5 administration, transportation, or medical services if such
- 6 restrictions are more restrictive in any aspect than those
- 7 applied to such coverage or payment as of July 1, 2007.
