## A BILL

To clarify the temporary suspension of duty on 9,10-Anthracenedione.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. 9,10-ANTHRACENEDIONE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The article description for head-  
5 ing 9902.24.05 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
6 United States is amended to read as follows: “9,10-  
7 Anthraquinone, 2-t-amyl (CAS No. 32588–54–8) and  
8 9,10-Anthraquinone, 2-iso-amyl (CAS No. 68892–28–4)  
9 (provided for in subheading 2914.69.60) or in organic so-  
10 lution (provided for in subheading 3824.90.28).”.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or with-  
3 drawn from warehouse for consumption on, or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this  
5 Act.

6           (2) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwith-  
7 standing section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19  
8 U.S.C. 1504) or any other provision of law, upon  
9 proper request filed with U.S. Customs and Border  
10 Protection before the date that is 90 days after the  
11 date of the enactment of this Act, any entry, or  
12 withdrawal from warehouse for consumption, of an  
13 article described in heading 9902.24.05 of the Har-  
14 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (as  
15 amended by subsection (a)) that was made—

16                   (A) after December 31, 2006, and

17                   (B) before the 15th day after the date of  
18 the enactment of this Act,

19 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though the  
20 amendment made by subsection (a) applied to such  
21 entry or withdrawal.

22           (3) PROPER REQUESTS.—For purposes of para-  
23 graph (2), a proper request means a request for liq-  
24 uidation or reliquidation that contains sufficient in-

1       formation to enable U.S. Customs and Border Pro-  
2       tection—

3                   (A) to locate the entry; or

4                   (B) to reconstruct the entry if it cannot be  
5       located.
