Mr. BURTON of Indiana introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on Trifluralin.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRIFLURALIN.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.05.33 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 Trifluralin) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “2.6%” and inserting “Free”;
8 and

9 (2) in the effective period column, by striking
10 the date contained therein and inserting “12/31/
11 2011”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
2 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
