## A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United  
States to clarify and extend the temporary duty reduc-  
tion on cellulose nitrate.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CELLULOSE NITRATE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.10.23 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       cellulose nitrate) is amended—

7               (1) by striking the text in the article description  
8       column and inserting “Cellulose nitrate (in powder  
9       form only, excluding collodions) with a nitrogen con-

1       tent of 12.2% by weight or less (CAS No. 9004–70–  
2       0) (provided for in subheading 3912.20.00)’’;

3               (2) by striking ‘‘4.4%’’ and inserting ‘‘1.5%’’;  
4       and

5               (3) in the effective period column, by striking  
6       the date contained therein and inserting ‘‘12/31/  
7       2011’’.

8       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
9       subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
10      warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
11      the date of the enactment of this Act.
