- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.24.43 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- $7\ \ 2\text{-Methyl-1-}[4\text{-}(\text{methylthio})\text{phenyl}]\text{-}2\text{-}(4\text{-morpholinyl})\text{-}1\text{-}$
- 8 propanone) is amended by striking the date in the effective
- 9 period column and inserting "12/31/2011".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
