- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.24.77 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 2,2-(2,5-Thiophenediyl)bis(5-(1,1-dimethylethyl)
- 8 benzoxazole)) is amended by striking the date in the effec-
- 9 tive period column and inserting "12/31/2011".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
