## A BILL

For the relief of Luis A. Gonzalez and Virginia Aguilla  
Gonzalez.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR LUIS A.**  
4                       **GONZALEZ AND VIRGINIA AGUILLA GON-**  
5                       **ZALEZ.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)  
7       and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality  
8       Act, Luis A. Gonzalez and Virginia Aguilla Gonzalez shall  
9       each be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for  
10       adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted  
11       for permanent residence upon filing an application for

1 issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such  
2 Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi-  
3 dent.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Luis A. Gonzalez  
5 or Virginia Aguilla Gonzalez enters the United States be-  
6 fore the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), he or  
7 she shall be considered to have entered and remained law-  
8 fully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjust-  
9 ment of status under section 245 of the Immigration and  
10 Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of this  
11 Act.

12 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
14 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-  
15 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees  
16 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
18 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent resi-  
19 dence to Luis A. Gonzalez and Virginia Aguilla Gonzalez,  
20 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to  
21 reduce by 2, during the current or next following fiscal  
22 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made  
23 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth  
24 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
25 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

1 that are made available to natives of the country of the  
2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.

3 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
4 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural  
5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Luis A. Gonzalez and Vir-  
6 ginia Aguilla Gonzalez shall not, by virtue of such relation-  
7 ship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status under the  
8 Immigration and Nationality Act.
