To suspend temporarily the duty on certain cathode ray
tubes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CATHODE RAY TUBES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.____	Cathode-ray data/graphic display tubes, color, with a phosphor dot screen pitch greater than or equal to 0.305 mm but less than 0.315 mm, a 90-degree deflection, a video display diagonal equal to or greater than 69.5 cm, and an aspect ratio of 1 to 1 (provided for in subheading 8540.40.00) ..	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
