A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on FOE
Hydroxy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FOE HYDROXY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.38 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) by striking “5.2%” and inserting “0.6%”;
8 and

9 (2) by striking “12/31/2009” and inserting
10 “12/31/2011”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
