A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on a certain chemical.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. POWDERED ION EXCHANGE RESIN COM-**
4 **PRISING A COPOLYMER OF STYRENE**
5 **CROSSLINKED WITH DIVINYLBENZENE,**
6 **SULPHONIC ACID, SODIUM FORM.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.02.34 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended
9 to read as follows:

“	9902.02.34	Powdered ion exchange resin comprised of a copolymer of styrene, cross linked with divinyl-benzene, further reacted to provide sulfonic acid functionality (sodium form), having a nominal particle size of 0.075 mm to 0.150 mm, dried to a moisture content of not more than 10% (CAS No. 63182-08-1) (provided for in subheading 3914.00.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
