HYDROXYLAMINE. 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.01.03 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-6 ed— (1) by striking "0.6%" and inserting "1.0%"; 7 8 and (2) by striking "12/31/2006" and inserting 9 "12/31/2012". 10
