A BILL

To provide for the reliquidation of certain drawback claims relating to certain speakers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF DRAWBACK CLAIMS RE-
4 LATING TO CERTAIN SPEAKERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
7 vision of law, U.S. Customs and Border Protection shall,
8 not later than 90 days or after the date of enactment of
9 this Act, reliquidate the entries described in subsection (c)
10 at the full amounts claimed in such entries.

1 (b) PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS OWED.—Any amounts
2 owed by the United States pursuant to the reliquidation
3 of an entry under subsection (a) shall be paid by U.S.
4 Customs and Border Protection within 90 days after such
5 reliquidation
