6	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Tilting arbor table saws with motors of an output equal to or greater than 1865 watts and less than 2611 watts and with contact detection and reaction systems (provided for in subheading 8465.91.00)

10 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by 11 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn 12 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day 13 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
