- 3 SECTION 1. FORMULATIONS OF THIAMETHOXAM, DIFENO-
- 4 CONAZOLE, FLUDIOXONIL, AND MEFENOXAM.
- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.13.31 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 formulations of Thiamethoxam, Difenoconazole, Fludiox-
- 8 onil, and Mefenoxam) is amended by striking "12/31/
- 9 2009" and by inserting "12/31/2011".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
