1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 **SECTION 1. FIPRONIL.** 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.24.16 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amend-6 ed— (1) by striking "Free" and inserting "5.2%"; 7 8 and (2) by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting 9 "12/31/2011". 10

(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by

12 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
