## A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on Carfentrazone.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. CARFENTRAZONE.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.01.54 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to Carfentrazone) is amended—

(1) by striking "(provided for in subheading 2933.99.22)" and inserting "(provided for in subheading 2933.99.22) and any formulations con-

taining such compound (provided for in subheading

- 1 (2) in the effective period column, by striking
- 2 the date contained therein and inserting "12/31/
- 3 2011".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 5 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 6 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 7 the date of the enactment of this Act.
