3 That notwithstanding any determination of the United
4 States Sentencing Commission to the contrary, amend-
5 ment number 9 of the “Amendments to the Sentencing
6 Guidelines, Policy Statements, and Official Commentary”
7 which was submitted by the United States Sentencing
8 Commission to Congress on May 1, 2007, pursuant to sec-
9 tion 994(p) of title 28, United States Code, shall apply

1 only to cases pending on and after the date that amend-
2 ment took effect.
