A BILL

To prohibit discrimination in Federal assisted health care services and research programs on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, or disability status.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Rights for
5 Health Care Act Title 42”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISCRIMINATION IN FEDERAL AS-**
2 **SISTED HEALTH CARE SERVICES AND RE-**
3 **SEARCH PROGRAMS ON THE BASIS OF SEX,**
4 **RACE, COLOR, NATIONAL ORIGIN, SEXUAL**
5 **ORIENTATION, OR DISABILITY STATUS.**

6 No person in the United States shall, on the basis
7 of sex, race, color, national origin, sexual orientation, or
8 disability status, be excluded from participation in, be de-
9 nied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination
10 under any health care service or research program or ac-
11 tivity receiving Federal financial assistance.
