A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Davis-Bacon Enforce-
- 5 ment Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN PREVAILING WAGE
- 7 PROVISIONS.
- 8 Section 3146 of title 40, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by adding at the end the following: "Notwith-
- 10 standing any other provision of law, any provision of Fed-

- 1 eral law that requires payment of prevailing wages as de-
- 2 termined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with
- 3 this subchapter shall be construed to include the debar-
- 4 ment provisions under section 3144(b)(2) of this title.".

5 SEC. 3. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION.

- 6 (a) GENERAL RULE.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
- 7 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
- 8 following:
- 9 "(7) The complete payroll records, including all infor-
- 10 mation contained therein but excluding the Social Security
- 11 numbers, established under a contract which is subject to
- 12 subchapter IV of subtitle II of chapter 31 of title 40,
- 13 United States Code, shall be made available, notwith-
- 14 standing subsection (b)(6).".
- 15 (b) Construction.—Section 552(a) of title 5,
- 16 United States Code, shall not be construed to prevent or
- 17 prohibit the disclosure required by section 552(a)(7) of
- 18 title 5, United States Code, as added by the amendment
- 19 made by subsection (a).
