A BILL

To penalize States that prohibit oil and gas exploration within their borders by denying them the use of any oil or natural gas produced domestically elsewhere.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. STATE HYPOCRISY REFORM.
- 4 (a) Any State that does not allow the exploration or
- 5 the production of oil or gas within that State's boundaries
- 6 or within the contiguous coastal zones of that State is pro-
- 7 hibited from receiving oil or gas produced in any other
- 8 State in the United States or its contiguous coastal zone.

- 1 (b) As used in this section the term "State" means
- 2 an entity that is a State of the United States, the District
- 3 of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Vir-
- 4 gin Islands of the United States, Guam, American Samoa,
- 5 the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, the Common-
- 6 wealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, or any territory
- 7 or possession of the United States, an Indian tribe, or a
- 8 unit of local government of that entity.
