A BILL

To extend the duty suspension on Crotonaldehyde (2-butenaldehyde).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CROTONALDEHYDE (2-BUTENALDEHYDE).**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.10.44 of the Har-
5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 Crotonaldehyde (2-butenaldehyde)) is amended by striking
7 “12/31/2009” and inserting “12/31/2011”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
10 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

1 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
2 this Act.
