A BILL

To repeal various provisions of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2008, relating to immigration and border security fencing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Immigration Law Cor-
5 rections Act of 2008”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESCISSION OF FUNDS FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICE**
2 **FOR IMMIGRATION REVIEW'S LEGAL ORI-**
3 **ENTATION PROGRAMS.**

4 Of the funds made available by the first paragraph
5 under the heading “Administrative Review and Appeals”
6 in title II of division B of the Consolidated Appropriations
7 Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–161), \$3,760,000 is re-
8 scinded, to be derived from the amount specified in the
9 proviso for the Executive Office for Immigration Review’s
10 Legal Orientation Programs.

11 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION OF FUNDS FOR INCREASED DEFENDER**
12 **SERVICES IN IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT**
13 **PROCEEDINGS.**

14 Of the funds made available by the second paragraph
15 under the heading “Defender Services” in title III of divi-
16 sion D of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2008
17 (Public Law 110–161), \$10,500,000 is rescinded.

18 **SEC. 4. REPEAL OF LIMITATION ON REQUIREMENT FOR**
19 **BORDER SECURITY FENCING.**

20 Section 102(b)(1) of the Illegal Immigration Reform
21 and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1103
22 note) is amended by striking subparagraph (D), as added
23 by section 564(a)(2) of division E of the Consolidated Ap-
24 propriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–161).
