A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to remove the discretion of the Secretary of Homeland Security with respect to expedited removal under section 235(b)(1)(A)(iii)(I) of such Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF DISCRETION TO ORDER EXPE-**
4 **DITED REMOVAL.**

5 Section 235(b)(1)(A)(iii)(I) of the Immigration and
6 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1225(b)(1)(A)(iii)(I)) is amend-
7 ed to read as follows:

1 “(I) IN GENERAL.—The Sec-
2 retary of Homeland Security shall
3 apply clauses (i) and (ii) of this sub-
4 paragraph to all aliens described in
5 subclause (II), except that if the Sec-
6 retary, after consulting with appro-
7 priate Federal, State, or local law en-
8 forcement agencies, determines that
9 the alien will be detained under the
10 authority of such an agency, the Sec-
11 retary may not remove the alien until
12 such detention terminates.”.
