6	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
12 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
13 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
