A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to repeal the additional 0.2 percent FUTA surtax.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF THE ADDITIONAL 0.2 PERCENT**
4 **FUTA SURTAX AND REBATE OF PAYROLL**
5 **TAXES PAID IN CALENDAR YEAR 2008.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3301 of the Internal Rev-
7 enue Code of 1986 (relating to rate of tax) is amended
8 by striking “equal to” and all that follows through “of
9 the total wages” and inserting “equal to 6.0 percent of
10 the total wages”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall apply to remuneration paid after De-
3 cember 31, 2007.
