A BILL

To deny a rebate of Federal income taxes to illegal immigrants.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. DENIAL OF 2008 REBATE OF FEDERAL INCOME 4 TAXES TO ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a nonresident alien individual shall not be eli-6 7 gible for a rebate of Federal income taxes provided by an Act of Congress enacted during 2008. 8 9 (b) Identification Number Requirement.— (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other 10

provision of law, no rebate of Federal income taxes

1	provided by an Act of Congress enacted during 2008
2	shall be allowed to an individual who does not in-
3	clude on the return of tax for the taxable year—
4	(A) such individual's valid identification
5	number,
6	(B) in the case of a joint return, the valid
7	identification number of such individual's
8	spouse, and
9	(C) in the case of any qualifying child
10	taken into account under such Act providing for
11	such rebate, the valid identification number of
12	such qualifying child.
13	(2) Valid identification number.—For pur-
14	poses of paragraph (1), the term "valid identifica-
15	tion number" means a social security number issued
16	to an individual by the Social Security Administra-
17	tion. Such term shall not include a TIN issued by
18	the Internal Revenue Service.
