3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN PEPPERONCINI PREPARED OR PRE-
4 SERVED OTHERWISE THAN BY VINEGAR OR
5 ACETIC ACID IN CONCENTRATIONS LESS
6 THAN 0.5 PERCENT.
