- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.23.31 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 lamp-holder housings of aluminum, containing sockets) is
- 8 amended by striking "12/31/2009" and inserting "12/31/
- 9 2011".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
