A BILL

To increase the supply and lower the cost of petroleum by temporarily suspending the acquisition of petroleum for the Strategic Petroleum Reserve.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strategic Petroleum
- 5 Reserve Fill Suspension and Consumer Protection Act of
- 6 2008".
- 7 SEC. 2. SUSPENSION OF PETROLEUM ACQUISITION FOR
- 8 STRATEGIC PETROLEUM RESERVE.
- 9 (a) In General.—Except as provided in subsection
- 10 (b) and notwithstanding any other provision of law, during

- 1 calendar year 2008, the Secretary of Energy shall suspend
- 2 acquisition of petroleum for the Strategic Petroleum Re-
- 3 serve through the royalty-in-kind program or any other
- 4 acquisition method.
- 5 (b) Resumption.—The Secretary may resume acqui-
- 6 sition of petroleum for the Strategic Petroleum Reserve
- 7 through the royalty-in-kind program or any other acquisi-
- 8 tion method during calendar year 2008 not earlier than
- 9 30 days after the date on which the Secretary notifies
- 10 Congress that the Secretary has determined that the
- 11 weighted average price of petroleum in the United States
- 12 for the most recent 90-day period is \$50 or less per barrel.
