## A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to eliminate the five-month waiting period in the disability insurance program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Social Security Fair-
- 5 ness for the Terminally Ill Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF TITLE II WAITING PERIOD FOR
- 7 TERMINALLY ILL INDIVIDUALS.
- 8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 223(a)(1) of the Social
- 9 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 423(a)(1)) is amended by adding
- 10 at the end the following new sentence: "In the case of any

- 1 application for disability insurance benefits filed by an in-
- 2 dividual who is determined to be under a disability and
- 3 who has been certified as terminally ill by a physician (as
- 4 defined in section 1861(r)(1), this paragraph shall be ap-
- 5 plied without regard to any waiting period. For the pur-
- 6 poses of the preceding sentence, an individual is consid-
- 7 ered to be terminally ill if the individual has a medical
- 8 prognosis that the individual's life expectancy is 6 months
- 9 or less.".
- 10 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 11 this section shall take effect with respect to applications
- 12 filed after the date of the enactment of this Act.
