A BILL

To amend the Federal Power Act to ensure that the mission and functions of Regional Transmission Organizations and Independent System Operators include keeping energy costs as low as reasonably possible for consumers, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Protection
- 5 and Cost Accountability Act".

1	SEC. 2. REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO TRANSMISSION OR-
2	GANIZATIONS.
3	(a) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:
4	(1) Commission.—The term "Commission"
5	means the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.
6	(2) Lowest Reasonable Cost.—The term
7	"lowest reasonable cost" means the lowest total de-
8	livered cost to consumers consistent with the provi-
9	sion of reliable service.
10	(3) Transmission organization.—The term
11	"Transmission Organization" has the meaning given
12	the term in section 3 of the Federal Power Act (16
13	U.S.C. 796).
14	(b) Rate and Charges; Schedules; Suspension
15	OF NEW RATES.—Section 205 of the Federal Power Act
16	(16 U.S.C. 824d) is amended by adding at the end the
17	following:
18	"(g) Requirements Relating to Transmission
19	Organizations.—
20	"(1) Definition of Lowest Reasonable
21	COST.—In this subsection, the term 'lowest reason-
22	able cost' means the lowest total delivered cost to
23	consumers consistent with the provision of reliable
24	service.
25	"(2) Consideration of transmission orga-
26	NIZATION RATES.—With respect to determining

whether a rate or charge made, demanded, or received (including any rule or regulation promulgated by a Transmission Organization relating to a rate or charge made, demanded, or received) is consistent with each requirement described in subsection (a) or section 206, as applicable, the Commission shall consider whether the rate or charge (including each rule or regulation relating to the rate or charge) would enable the Transmission Organization to provide, or facilitate the provision of, reliable service to consumers at the lowest reasonable cost.

"(3) Consideration of transmission organization relating to the rate or charge made, demanded, or received (including any rule or regulation promulgated by a Transmission Organization relating to a rate or charge made, demanded, or received) is consistent with each requirement described in subsection (a), the Commission shall consider whether the rate or charge (including each rule or regulation relating to the rate or charge) would—

"(A) provide consumer benefits that outweigh any anticipated direct or indirect costs to consumers, as demonstrated by a cost-benefit

1	analysis to be submitted by the Transmission
2	Organization to the Commission; or
3	"(B) have only a de minimus impact on
4	the total delivered costs to consumer.
5	"(4) Biennial Audits.—The Commission shall
6	ensure that each Transmission Organization is sub-
7	ject to biennial, independent audits that—
8	"(A) include—
9	"(i) an assessment of the performance
10	of the Transmission Organization; and
11	"(ii) recommendations to lower the
12	costs and improve the performance of the
13	Transmission Organization; and
14	"(B) are made available to the public.".
15	(c) Annual Reports.—Not later than 1 year after
16	the date of enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter,
17	the Commission shall submit to the appropriate commit-
18	tees of Congress a report describing each determination
19	of the Commission with respect to whether each Trans-
20	mission Organization provides, or facilitates the provision
21	of, reliable service at the lowest reasonable cost to con-
22	sumers
