A BILL

To provide for the continued availability of automated stamp vending machines at facilities of the United States Postal Service serving underserved communities, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Postal Service Access
- 5 Assurance Act of 2008".

1	SEC. 2. ACCESS TO AUTOMATED STAMP VENDING MA-
2	CHINES.
3	The United States Postal Service shall take such ac-
4	tion as may be appropriate to ensure that, to the max-
5	imum extent practicable, automated stamp vending ma-
6	chines are provided at all facilities which—
7	(1) are owned by or under the control of the
8	United States Postal Service; and
9	(2) provide retail services to the public.
10	SEC. 3. EXCLUSION FROM PROVISIONS REQUIRING AC-
11	CEPTANCE OF \$1 COINS.
12	Section 5112(p) of title 31, United States Code, is

14	"(6) Exclusion of Automated Stamp Vending
