- 7 accompanying the conference report on H.R. 2082 of the
- 8 110th Congress (H. Rept. 110–478) in compliance with
- 9 clause 9 of rule XXI of the Rules of the House of Rep-
- 10 resentatives and rule XLIV of the Standing Rules of the

- 1 Senate, unless the President certifies that amounts would
- 2 be obligated for such item without regard to its appear-

3 ance in such joint explanatory statement.
