AN ACT

To extend for 5 years the EB–5 regional center pilot program, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EB-5 REGIONAL CENTER PILOT

- PROGRAM.
- 3 Section 610(b) of the Departments of Commerce,
- 4 Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related Agencies
- 5 Appropriations Act, 1993 (8 U.S.C. 1153 note) is amend-
- 6 ed by striking "shall set aside" and all that follows
- 7 through "eligible for admission" and inserting "shall set
- 8 aside 3,000 visas annually for 20 years to include such
- 9 aliens as are eligible for admission".

10 SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.

- It is the sense of the Congress that, to the extent
- 12 practicable, qualifying investments under section 610 of
- 13 the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State, the Ju-
- 14 diciary, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1993
- 15 (8 U.S.C. 1153 note) should be made in targeted employ-
- 16 ment areas (as defined in section 203(b)(5)(B)(ii) of the
- 17 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 18 1153(b)(5)(B)(ii))), including rural areas (areas other
- 19 than an area within a metropolitan statistical area or
- 20 within the outer boundary of any city or town having a
- 21 population of 20,000 or more (based on the most recent
- 22 decennial census of the United States)) and high unem-

- 1 ployment areas (areas that have experienced unemploy-
- 2 ment of at least 150 percent of the national average rate).
