A BILL

To prohibit the transport of hydrolysate from the Pueblo Chemical Depot, Colorado, or the Blue Grass Army Depot, Kentucky, to an off-site location.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON TRANSPORT OF HYDROLY-
4 SATE AT CERTAIN ARMY DEPOTS.**

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Secretary of Defense may
6 not transport hydrolysate from the Pueblo Chemical
7 Depot, Colorado, or the Blue Grass Army Depot, Ken-
8 tucky, to an off-site location for treatment, storage, or dis-
9 posal.

1 (b) SAVINGS CLAUSE.—Nothing in this Act limits or
2 otherwise affects section 8119 of the Department of De-
3 fense Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–116; 50
4 U.S.C. 1521 note).
