A BILL

To provide for transitional health care for members of the Armed Forces separated from active duty who agree to serve in the Selected Reserve of the Ready Reserve.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TRANSITIONAL HEALTH CARE FOR CERTAIN**
2 **MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO**
3 **AGREE TO SERVE IN THE SELECTED RE-**
4 **SERVE OF THE READY RESERVE.**

5 (a) PROVISION OF TRANSITIONAL HEALTH CARE.—
6 Section 1145(a)(2) of title 10, United States Code, is
7 amended by adding at the end the following new subpara-
8 graph:

9 “(E) A member who is separated from active
10 duty who agrees to become a member of the Selected
11 Reserve of the Ready Reserve of a reserve compo-
12 nent.”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subparagraph (E) of section
14 1145(a)(2) of title 10, United States Code, as added by
15 subsection (a), shall apply with respect to members of the
16 Armed Forces separated from active duty after the date
17 of the enactment of this Act.
