- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN CIGARS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Chapter 24 of the Harmonized
- 5 Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended by strik-
- 6 ing subheading 2402.10.80 and inserting the following
- 7 new subheadings and superior text thereto, with such su-
- 8 perior text having the same degree of indentation as the
- 9 article description for subheading 2402.10.80 as in effect
- 10 immediately before the enactment of this Act:

"	2402.10.80	Each valued 23¢ or over: Cigars certified as handmade	57¢/kg + 1.4%	Free (A, AU, BH, CA, CL, E, IL, J, MA, MX, P, SG)	\$9.92/kg + 25%	
	2402.10.90	Other	57¢/kg + 1.4%	Free (A, AU, BH, CA, CL, E, IL, J, MA, MX, P, SG)	\$9.92/kg + 25%	,,.

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
