A BILL

To amend the Missing Children's Assistance Act to expand the definition of missing child for purposes of that Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO THE MISSING CHILDREN'S ASSISTANCE ACT.

Section 403(1) of the Missing Children's Assistance

Act (42 U.S.C. 5772(1)) is amended—

(1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A)
by striking "whose whereabouts are unknown to

such individual's legal custodian if",

1	(2) in subparagraphs (A), (B), and (C)—
2	(A) by redesignating such subparagraphs
3	as clauses (i), (ii), and (iii), respectively, and
4	(B) by indenting the left margin of such
5	subparagraphs 2 ems to the right,
6	(3) by inserting before clause (i), as so redesig-
7	nated, the following:
8	"(A) whose whereabouts are unknown to
9	such individual's legal custodian if—", and
10	(4) by adding at the end the following:
11	"(B) whose whereabouts are known to
12	such individual's legal custodian from whose
13	control such child—
14	"(i) was removed in violation of law;
15	or
16	"(ii) is believed by such custodian to
17	have been taken out of the United States
18	without the consent of such custodian by,
19	or for the benefit of, an individual who
20	may possibly claim custodial rights with re-
21	spect to such child;".
