Mr. Gene Green of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Enrique Soriano, Cleotilde Soriano, and Areli Soriano.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ENRIQUE

SORIANO, CLEOTILDE SORIANO, AND ARELI

SORIANO.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)

and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality

Act, Enrique Soriano, Cleotilde Soriano, and Areli Soriano

shall each be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa

or for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully

admitted for permanent residence upon filing an applica-

- 1 tion for issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204
- 2 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful perma-
- 3 nent resident.
- 4 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Enrique Soriano,
- 5 Cleotilde Soriano, and Areli Soriano enters the United
- 6 States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c),
- 7 he or she shall be considered to have entered and remained
- 8 lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for ad-
- 9 justment of status under section 245 of the Immigration
- 10 and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of
- 11 this Act.
- 12 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 13 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 14 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
- 15 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
- 16 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 17 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Number.—
- 18 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 19 idence to Enrique Soriano, Cleotilde Soriano, and Areli
- 20 Soriano, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
- 21 officer to reduce by 3, during the current or next following
- 22 fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are
- 23 made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
- 24 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 25 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

- 1 that are made available to natives of the country of the
- 2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
- 3 (e) Denial of Preferential Immigration
- 4 Treatment for Certain Relatives.—The natural
- 5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Enrique Soriano,
- 6 Cleotilde Soriano, and Areli Soriano shall not, by virtue
- 7 of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or
- 8 status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
