## A BILL

To expand the definition of independent student in the Higher Education Act of 1965 to include homeless youth.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "FAFSA Fix for Home-
- 5 less Kids Act''.
- 6 SEC. 2. HOMELESS YOUTH INCLUDED IN DEFINITION OF
- 7 INDEPENDENT STUDENT.
- 8 Section 480(d) of the Higher Education Act of 1965
- 9 (20 U.S.C. 1087vv(d)) is amended—

1	(1) by redesignating paragraphs (6) and (7) as
2	paragraphs (7) and (8), respectively; and
3	(2) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
4	lowing new paragraph:
5	"(6) has been verified as both a homeless child
6	or youth and an unaccompanied youth, as such
7	terms are defined in section 725 of the McKinney-
8	Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a),
9	during the school year in which the application for
10	financial assistance is submitted, by—
11	"(A) a local educational agency liaison for
12	homeless children and youths, as designated
13	under section 722(g)(1)(J)(ii) of the McKinney-
14	Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
15	11432(g)(1)(J)(ii));
16	"(B) a director of a homeless shelter, tran-
17	sitional shelter, or independent living program;
18	or
19	"(C) a financial aid administrator;".
