A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to ensure that participants in the Troops to Teachers program may teach at a range of eligible schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Troops to Teachers
5 Improvement Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND FINANCIAL AS-**2 **SISTANCE UNDER TROOPS TO TEACHERS**3 **PROGRAM.**

4 Section 2304 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 is amended in subsection (a)(1)(B) by striking “for not less than 3 school years” and all that follows through the period at the end and inserting the following: “for not less than 3 school years, to begin the school year after obtaining that certification or licensing, with a high-need local educational agency or public charter school, as such terms are defined in section 2101 or, if there is no high-need local educational agency or public charter school for which the member is qualified to teach within a 50-mile radius of the member’s residence, then under circumstances covered by section 2302(b)(2).”.
