AN ACT

To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater
Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of
the Interior to participate in the Santa Rosa Urban
Water Reuse Plan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Santa Rosa Urban
3 Water Reuse Plan Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROJECT AUTHORIZATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Wastewater and
6 Groundwater Study and Facilities Act (Public Law 102–
7 575, title XVI; 43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following new section:

9 **“SEC. 16____. CITY OF SANTA ROSA, CALIFORNIA, URBAN**
10 **WATER REUSE PLAN.**

11 “(a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary, in coopera-
12 tion with the City of Santa Rosa, California, is authorized
13 to participate in the design, planning, and construction of
14 projects to implement the plan titled ‘Santa Rosa Urban
15 Water Reuse Plan’.

16 “(b) COST SHARE.—The Federal share of the costs
17 of the projects authorized by this section shall not exceed
18 25 percent of the total cost. The Secretary shall credit
19 the City of Santa Rosa with the value of all expenditures
20 made before the date of the enactment of this section that
21 are used toward completion of projects that are compatible
22 with this section.

23 “(c) LIMITATIONS.—

24 “(1) Federal funds shall not be used for the op-
25 eration or maintenance of a project authorized by
26 this section.

4 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
5 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
6 \$20,000,000.”.

(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The table of sections in section 2 of Public Law 102–575 is amended by inserting after the last item relating to title XVI the following:

“Sec. 16____. City of Santa Rosa, California, Urban Water Reuse Plan.”.
