Mr. McHUGH introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for defense and for the reconstruction of Iraq for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and requiring the President to submit a request for additional funding after certifying substantial progress has been made in Iraq in meeting certain performance measures.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any
4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, and for other pur-
6 poses, namely:

1 **TITLE I—DEFENSE-RELATED APPROPRIATIONS**

2 For military functions administered by the Department
3 of Defense, for necessary expenses to carry out military
4 operations in Iraq, \$25,000,000,000, to remain available
5 until September 30, 2007.

6 **TITLE II—IRAQ RELIEF AND RECONSTRUCTION**

7 For necessary expenses to carry out the purposes of
8 the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, for security, relief,
9 rehabilitation, and reconstruction in Iraq,
10 \$25,000,000,000, to remain available until September 30,
11 2007.

12 **TITLE III—GENERAL PROVISIONS**

13 SEC. 301. Not later than July 1, 2007, the President
14 shall transmit to Congress a request for such additional
15 appropriations for the remainder of fiscal year 2007 as
16 the President considers necessary for defense and for the
17 reconstruction of Iraq.

18 SEC. 302. It is the sense of Congress that Congress
19 should consider providing additional appropriations pursuant
20 to any request transmitted by the President pursuant
21 to section 301 predicated on progress by the Government
22 of Iraq in achieving the performance measures listed in
23 section 303(b), as described in the most recent report
24 transmitted by the President under section 303(a).

1 SEC. 303. (a) Not later than March 1, 2007, and
2 every month thereafter, the President shall transmit to
3 Congress a report containing—

4 (1) a description and analysis of the implemen-
5 tation in Iraq of the performance measures listed in
6 subsection (b); and

7 (2) a certification that progress is being made
8 on the achievement of such performance measures.

9 (b) The performance measures listed in this sub-
10 section are the following:

11 (1) **IRAQI FORCES.**—The appointment of a mili-
12 tary commander and two deputy commanders for
13 Baghdad, the provision of three additional Iraqi
14 Army brigades, and the provision of additional Iraqi
15 National Police forces for assignment to Baghdad
16 for the purpose of peacekeeping activities to be car-
17 ried out jointly by the United States and the Gov-
18 ernment of Iraq.

19 (2) **OIL REVENUE SHARING LAW.**—The passage
20 and implementation of a law to allow oil revenue to
21 be shared with all citizens of Iraq.

22 (3) **REFORMED DE-BAATHIFICATION PROC-
23 ESS.**—The institution of a reformed de-
24 Baathification process under which members critical

1 to the functioning of a civil society are allowed to re-
2 enter Iraq's political and economic life.

3 (4) DISARMAMENT OF MILITIAS.—The achieve-
4 ment of the disarmament of militias in Iraq, includ-
5 ing the Badr Brigade and Jaish al Mahdi.

6 (5) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.—The provision
7 of \$10,000,000 by the Government of Iraq for re-
8 construction, including an effective jobs creation pro-
9 gram.

10 (6) CONSTITUTIONAL REFORM.—The imple-
11 mentation of the special process for amending the
12 Constitution of the Republic of Iraq that is called
13 for by the provisions of Article 137 of such Constitu-
14 tion.

15 (c) The report required by subsection (a) shall be
16 transmitted in unclassified form but may contain a classi-
17 fied annex.

18 This Act may be cited as the “Supplemental Appro-
19 priations Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of
20 Iraq, 2007”.
